1, 0 km swim, 100 km bike, 10 km run

TriStar111 Worms-Germany Relay

1, 0 km swim, 100 km bike, 10 km run

start allowance:

Tristar111 Worms-Germany single starter

To apply as a single starter for the TriStar111 you must be 20 years or older. You will need a valid start pass or a day-license.

TriStar111 Worms-Germany Relay

For the TriStar111 Relay all starters in the team must be 18 years or older. Every relay must have 3 starters, one swimmer, one biker, one runner. You have the choice to start as a woman-, a men- or a mix-relay. The transponder has to be given to the next team member in the „TEAM RELAY- Zone“.

TriStar111 relay-starters do not need a start pass or a day license.

A special qualification or a club membership is also not mandatory.

Forwarding or swapping a start allowance without consent from the organization will lead to disqualification. The organizer can also disapprove a start allowance or release suspension due to important reasons.

Day liscence:

The day liscence will cost you € 16,- and has to be paid on the day of the event.

Costs for the Energy Night Party:

Every TriStar 111 athlete can buy a ticket fort he Energy Night Party for € 15,- either with the application or on the day of the Party at the cash-desk (as long as tickets are available).

You can also buy tickets for your companions, family members or friends € 15,-. These tickets must be bought with the application, there will only be a limited number of tickets available on the day of the event.

Please note: The Energy Night Party is on Saturday, June 9th 2012.

All prices are inclusive service costs and German VAT.

Application:

The application is only possible via the internet sites www.star-events.cc or www.activeglobal.com.

Every athlete must pick up the start documents personally and must be able to show these documents and a personal ID-Card at the registration or any other control-check. Every athlete must sign a declaration that they accept the rules and the eligibility requirements as well as a indemnity towards the organizer and other attendants.

There is no right to receive the start fees back, when not attending.

Registration conformation:

The starting launches will be given out after payment. Athletes will receive a registration conformation by e-mail to the e-mail adress given in the application.

Late registration:

Registrations after Mai 28th 2012 are not possible.

Provisions:

During and after the race the athletes will be provided with water, isotonic drinks and fruit at the energy stations.

Certificates

Certificates will be provided on the internet platform for everyone to print out.

Registration:

Registration and collection of the start documents is only possible within the opening hours of the registration office.

Important: Athletes that have collected their start documents are registered. They are then bound to inform the organizer immediately if they resign the start. For this case use the contact details on page 1 of this announcement. Any originated costs for a search, in case of lack of information by the athlete are to be taken by the athlete.

Race regulations:

The event has those rules given by the German Triathlon Union (race order, event order, Anti-Doping-Order, referee order), as well as the legal order and the code of procedure. These can be found here: www.dtu-info.de/ordnungen.html and will also be lying out at the registration desk. With the application every athlete is bound to these race regulations as well as the legal order and the code of procedure. Every attendant is also bound to the german road traffic regulations (Road Traffic Regulations/Commanded the right driving) Further information to the topic Anti-Doping can be found here: www.nada-bonn.de.

Athletes Briefing:

There will be an athletes briefing on Saturday, 09. June 2012 at 18.30 o'clock before the Energy Night Party and is mandatory for everyone.

Drafting:

Drafting is forbidden. The size of the drafting box is 3 x 10 m.

Race Referees:

License Referees from DTU and RTV



Arbitrator:

Arbitrator will be named on the day of the event.

Swim-cap/ Helmet:

On the bike a helmet is mandatory (DTU Sport Order).

When swimming you must wear the swim-cap you are given from the organizer.

Routes of TriStar111 Worms-Germany:

Swim route

1000 Meter in the harbor of Worms.

Wetsuits and swimcaps are mandatory. According to the Rheinland-Pfälzischen Triathlon Association speed suits are forbidden.

Bike route

100 Km through the wine hills of Rheinhessen

The transition zone is located on the fairground (Festplatz) in Worms. After changing onto your bike, you go through town onto your first 50-km-round. The first 15 km are quite even, then you reach the hilly wine fields with pretty little villages and a beautiful landscape along the route. Back in Worms you get to the fairground and go on the exact same route a second time. At this point you family and friends have the chance to see and support you going on your second round. After the second round you get to the transition zone 2. This is on the same fairground as the transition zone 1.

Run route

After your have chanced from your bike into your running shoes you start with the 10 km running route. On this route from the transition are into the old part of Worms, you will pass 2 centuries of Worms' history. Nearby the Worms cathedral you will find an Energy Station, where we will provide with drinks etc for the second part of the running route. On your way back to the transition zone you will run over spectacular Nibelungenbridge back to Hessen. After this you start on your second round. This again gives your family and friend the chance to see and support you on the way. After your seconds round you reach the new arranged home straight on the riverbank of the Rhein. Here you can then enjoy the sensational atmosphere, when you reach the finish-line.

Transition Area

There is only one transition area.

All athletes receive a Pre-Race-Bag, which we will collect at the swim-start and you can pick up after the race in the Relaxing Zone. We advise you to wear shoes when walking from the transition area to the swim start.



Time measurement:

The Time chips will be given out by the organizer and must be given back after you have passed the finish-line.

Time limits TriStar111 Worms-Germany:

Swim

1 hour

Bike

4 hours to km 60 (Osthofen)

Medical care/First aid:

Medical care and first aid will be provided by a doctor or medics right after the race. Sanitations are also available.

Custody in the transition area:

The transition area is secured by a fence. Bikes and Bags will only be given out after showing a valid bike-pass. The custody ends one hour after the last athlete has passed the finish-line. Afterwards all bikes and Bags that have not yet been picked up, will be delivered to the race office.

Lost and Found:

Found items will be collected in the race office.

Adhesion:

The organizer is not responsible for roughly negligently caused special and financial damages. Exceptional from this limitation of liability damage, which is based on the culpable injury of a contractual main obligation to perform of the organizer. The managing limitations of liability extend to the personal compensation adhesion of the employees, representatives, executing aides and those who are in any connection with the organizer.

The final sport insurance excludes mutual requirements for liability of the participants. A private additional insurance is recommended. The rules of the DTU as well as road traffic regulations are to be kept. The adhesion of the organizer or its fulfilment or performing assistants for other damage than such from the injury of life, body or health is impossible, as far as it is not based on a deliberate or roughly negligent obligation injury of the organizer or its legal representative or executing aid. The organizer does not take over adhesion for free of charge kept articles
